ASSEMBLY - UNFOLD FRAME

Please follow these steps to unfold the frame as required:



1. Pull the frame with rear wheels away from the main frame of walking tutor.
2. Rotate the locking bracket down to fix rear legs in place.




To fold the walker tutor for transit or storage:
Rotate the locking bracket up and push the rear wheel frame in towards the main frame of walking tutor.


ASSEMBLY - FIT UPRIGHTS

Please follow these steps to fit the uprights onto the frame as required:

1. Remove the hand wheel, washer and bolt from the upright tube.
2. Align the upright with the frame as shown.
3. Insert upright into frame.
4. Align required hole in upright with hole in frame.
5. From the inside face - Insert the bolt into the hex hole. Ensure the head of the bolt sits inside hex hole.
6. Slide washer onto bolt and screw hand wheel onto bolt.
7. Repeat process to fit other upright.



Height settings
(from forearm pad to floor):
Hole 1: 965mm
Hole 2: 990mm
Hole 3: 1015mm
Hole 4: 1040mm
Hole 5: 1065mm
Hole 6: 1090mm
Hole 7: 1115mm
Hole 8: 1140mm



ASSEMBLY - FIT HANDLES

Please follow these steps to fit the handles onto the uprights as required:




1. Line up tube on handle with tube on underside of forearm pad with the hand grip and brake lever facing up.
2. Slide handle in to the required depth.
3. Tighten lever to fix handle in place.



ASSEMBLY - FIT TRAY

Please follow these steps to fit the tray onto the walking tutor as required:

1. Line up pins on underside of tray with holes in top of seat.
2. Firmly push tray down onto seat.





Tray max. load: **2kg**

ASSEMBLY - FIT BASKET

Please follow these steps to fit the basket onto the walking tutor as required:



1. Centrally align the basket with the front of the walking tutor.
2. Hook the top rim of the basket onto the two hooks located on the crossbar underneath the seat.



IMPORTANT NOTE

Do not overload basket

Max. load: **5kg**




OPERATION - BRAKES

The walking tutor has independant hand brakes on both handles.

IMPORTANT NOTE:


Both hand brakes should be used simultaneously to ensure the walking tutor stops as required and the user is in full control.



SLOW DOWN AND STOP

To slow down or stop the walking tutor from rolling gently pull back on both hand brakes simultaneously.

Release both hand brakes to allow the walking tutor to move again.




PARK BRAKE

To engage the park brakes on the walking tutor gently push forward on both hand brakes simultaneously until a loud click is heard.

This will stop the walking tutor from rolling.

To release park brakes pull back on both hand brakes simultaneously until a loud click is heard.

USER GUIDELINES - SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Please follow these guidelines to get the optimal benefit from walking tutor. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in damage to the product and put the user at risk.

Maximum user weight of walking tutor is **120kg**.

Do not overload the wire basket under seat. (Max. load: 5kg)

Periodically inspect the walking tutor prior to use to ensure it is in good working order. Always check that brakes are working prior to use.

The walking tutor is designed to be used indoors and outdoors.

Take care when using the walking tutor on uneven or wet ground.

Never self propel the walking tutor while seated.
(The walking tutor is not a wheelchair)

Take care when walking tutor is in the folded position as it may fall over if not supported or laid down.

Never hang any objects off the side of the walking tutor as it may tip over.

Ensure all four wheels remain in contact with the ground when the walking tutor is in use. Do not lean too far to one side or lean backwards causing the wheels to leave the ground.

PRODUCT CARE - INSPECTIONS / CLEANING

INSPECTIONS

We suggest that you visually check the walking tutor periodically for signs of damage or wear prior to use, paying particular attention to the following areas:

Framework – check for damage or distortion.

Wheels - check to ensure walking tutor rolls as required

Brakes - check to ensure both brakes work as required (brake and park brake)

Hand grips / Forearm pads - check for cracks / tears in material

Overall check that no components are loose or worn and walking tutor operates as required.




Withdraw the walking tutor immediately if you suspect damage or any other fault. If in any doubt, please do not issue or use, but immediately contact your supplier for service support.

CLEANING

Clean the walking tutor using a non-abrasive cleaner or mild detergent with a soft cloth.

Abrasive cleaners or abrasive cleaning pads could damage the walking tutor and should not be used.

WARRANTY

REDGUM Brand walking tutor is covered by a 12 month warranty from the date of purchase.
