


LONG HANDLE HAIR BRUSH



USAGE GUIDELINES

Use the Long Handle Hair Brush if you struggle to reach using a normal brush.

CLEANING

Periodically remove any built up hair from the brush head.

Clean the Long Handle Hair Brush using anti bacterial wipes or a non-abrasive cleaner.

Abrasive cleaners or abrasive cleaning pads could damage the Long Handle Hair Brush and should not be used.

INSPECTIONS

We suggest that you check the Long Handle Hair Brush visually periodically for signs of damage or wear prior to use.

Withdraw the Long Handle Hair Brush immediately if you suspect damage or any other fault.

If in any doubt, please do not issue or use, but immediately contact your supplier for support.

WARRANTY

Redgum Brand Long Hair Brush (RG71HB) is covered by a 12 Month Warranty from the date of purchase.

If the product has any manufacturing faults during this period contact the place of purchase for assessment.

Failures as a result of ACCIDENTAL MISUSE, MODIFICATION OR WEAR AND TEAR ARE NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY.
