INSPECT SUPPLIED PRODUCT If you see any damage or suspect a fault, DO NOT USE THE PRODUCT and contact your supplier for support.






USAGE GUIDELINES





 Place the sock holder in between your thighs and squeeze to hold sock aid in place.



2. Bunch the sock up and slide onto the sock holder.




3. Pull the sock completely over the sock holder.



 Holding the straps, place the sock holder on the ground in front of you and slide your foot in.



5. Using the straps, pull the sock holder onto your foot.



Once the sock is on foot, carefully slide the sock holder out behind your leg.

INSPECTIONS

We suggest that you check the Sock Aid visually periodically for signs of damage or wear prior to use. Withdraw the Sock Aid immediately if you suspect damage or any other fault. If in any doubt, please do not issue or use, but immediately contact your supplier for support.

CLEANING

Clean the Sock Aid with warm soapy water if required and allow to dry prior to use. Abrasive cleaners or abrasive cleaning pads could damage the Sock Aid and should not be used.

WARRANTY

Redgum Brand Sock Aid (RG71SA) is covered by a 12 Month Warranty from the date of purchase.

If the product has any manufacturing faults during this period contact the place of purchase for assessment. Failures as a result of ACCIDENTAL MISUSE, MODIFICATION OR WEAR AND TEAR ARE NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement part for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage.
